Mayor and Council, Citizens of Van Alstyne:

I would like to take a moment to extend my sincere appreciation to everyone who participated in and attended the groundbreaking ceremony for the Van Alstyne Public Safety Facility on June 5th. This 47,133 square foot facility, designed to serve both our police and fire departments, is scheduled for completion and occupancy in late 2026.

Summer is in full swing in Van Alstyne and it's going to be a busy one! Thanks to our dedicated staff, community partners, and volunteers there are exciting activities nearly every day. Behind the scenes, finance staff are working diligently with auditors while executive leadership has begun preliminary work on the fiscal year 2026 budget.

Utility Billing has also implemented improvements that will allow customers to easily access billing information and payment options including pay by phone, text, online, or in our app.

Project Updates

- US HWY 75: TxDOT has begun work to convert traffic on frontage roads to one-way. The addition of a u-turn bridge near Northridge Rd and Simmons Loop, widening US 75 mainlanes from four to six lanes, improvements to the underpass at Van Alstyne Pkwy, and replacement of the County Line Rd bridge are all part of this project with anticipated completion in 2028.
- FM 121 (E Jefferson St) RR to Lincoln Park Rd: TxDOT is awaiting DART approval to pave this section of roadway one lane at a time to minimize the impact to traffic. The contractor will mill three inches, improve the base to provide smooth travel, and install three inches of new asphalt.
- Shared Use Path, Phase 3: A culvert was installed on Main Dr just south of Tolson Ave last week. Seven feet of asphalt will be added to the narrow portion of roadway in the same area with anticipated project completion in July 2025.
