

RECYCLING COLLECTION REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Residents must use the 95-gallon Blue polycart for curbside recycle collection. Collection is twice monthly, done on Mondays.
- 2. Each resident will be given one (1) 95-gallon polycart.
- 3. Additional units will carry an additional charge. Please contact City Hall at 903-482-5426 to request additional carts.
- 4. The polycart will remain the property of the contractor which means that damaged or stolen polycart will be replaced at no charge to the resident.
- 5. To prevent any unnecessary leaks, spills, and garbage throughout the community; lids should remain closed at all times. Any materials that do not fit in the polycart with a closed lid should be placed as bulk waste (at the curb, next to the polycart) on the resident's normal garbage collection day.
- 6. All 95-gallon polycart shall be placed at a single collection point within three (3) feet of the street curb.
- 7. Polycart can be placed at the curb as early as 4:00 PM the day before the scheduled collection, but no later than 7:00 AM on the day of collection.
- 8. It is the responsibility of the resident to bring their polycart back into the yard within 24 hours of being emptied.
- 9. **Materials that may be recycled** Aluminum, steel, tin cans; cardboard, cartons, catalogs, glass bottles or jars, junk mail, magazines, newspaper, phone books, plastics 1-5, 7. All items should be rinsed out before placing out for recycling.
- 10. **Materials that may NOT be recycled** Aluminum foil, batteries of any sort, packing peanuts, plastic bags, Styrofoam, household hazardous waste, electronics, yard waste of any kind.
- 11. It is the responsibility of the occupant of the property to keep the area around the garbage receptacles clean and in a sanitary condition and they must comply with City Staff's instructions.
